3. Laurelwood Arboretum may deny any application for a permit, or for a specific date and/or time, in its sole discretion.

Applicant agrees to grant to Friends of Laurelwood Arboretum, its representatives and employees, the right to take photographs of my wedding ceremony, and I authorize Friends of Laurelwood Arboretum to use and publish the same, with or without my name, for any lawful purpose, including for publicity, illustration, advertising, and website/social media content.

POLICIES FOR WEDDING CEREMONIES AT LAURELWOOD ARBORETUM

We are delighted that you have chosen to have your wedding ceremony at Laurelwood Arboretum – congratulations! A complimentary annual membership in Friends of Laurelwood Arboretum will be provided for the newlyweds.

The following policies apply to all participants of a wedding ceremony at Laurelwood.

- We ask that you and your guests help preserve Laurelwood Arboretum by leaving the Arboretum as it was found. Please take any and all items brought into the Arboretum with you when leaving.
- Please stay on the pathways and do not tread or place any objects in the gardens, streams or ponds.
- Please do not tamper with any Arboretum property, including trees, plants, signs and structures.
- All guests must park in designated parking lots. No unauthorized motor vehicles are permitted on the Arboretum's roadways. Arrangements may be made in advance for the use of a motorized cart operated by a Laurelwood Arboretum volunteer or employee.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles or drones is not allowed in the Arboretum.
- Smoking, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs and ballplaying are prohibited on the premises.
- The Arboretum is a public park and we have many visitors. Please do not interfere with their enjoyment of the grounds. We would also appreciate allowing staff and volunteers to do their jobs in the Arboretum without interference. We encourage respect and courtesy among all users of the Arboretum.
- In case of inclement weather, the wedding ceremony may be held indoors in the Knippenberg Center for Education. If an indoor ceremony is not desired, a full refund will be made.
