A Sculpture Trail

The creative placement of curated sculptures by prominent artists is underway, enhancing the park by complementing its landscape and serene setting. In addition to docent and audio tours, school-age and adult educational programs are being developed. All sculptures will be available for sale through an exclusive agreement with "Broadfoot & Broadfoot, A Collection of Fine Art," Boonton, NJ. A percentage of the proceeds will be donated to the Friends of Laurelwood Arboretum, a 501(c)(3), and will be applied to the installation of deer fencing to manage the herds which have encroached the park. "Sneak Peak" activities will occur during the weekend of June 5-6, 2021. Details will be posted at laurelwoodarboretum.org/ as they unfold.

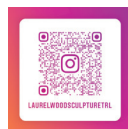

Laurelwood Arboretum is located at 725 Pines Lake Drive West in Wayne, NJ. The arboretum is open and free to the public, every day, 8 am to dusk, except during emergency conditions. Public parking lots are located through the open gates on Vale Road and Pines Lake Drive West.

The Knippenberg Center for Education is located near the parking lots with accessible parking adjacent to the building. The center is open April through October, noon to 4 pm Tuesdays through Sundays except during emergency conditions. Accessible bathrooms are available when the building is open.
